We have also enjoyed talking about our special families and then drawing beautiful pictures of them.

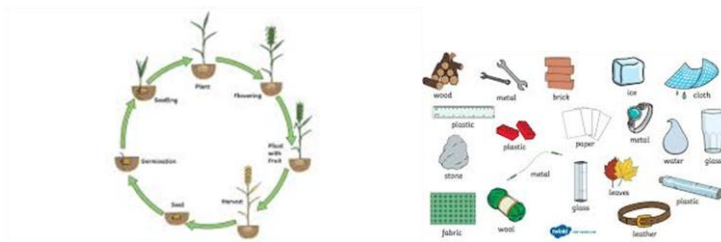
The children loved sharing the classroom with the adults during our stay and play. We are very grateful for all the kind words of support.

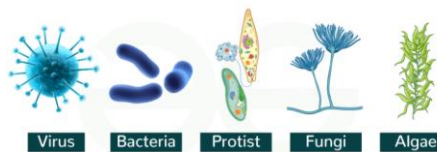




### Upper Key Stage 2
